

# Flagstone Loosely Spaced & Not Grouted

*Compacted ground*  
*Plantex membrane*  
*Mortar mixture*  
*Grout gap 80 - 100 mm*  
*Flagstone*

## Flagstone Paving Laying Specification

### Soil Preparation

Compact ground with hand stamper or plate compactor for larger areas.

### Mortar Mixture

3 parts building sand.

1 part cement (only CEM II V42.5- V with flyash) NOT S for Slagment.

Mix to a brick mortar consistency.

### Application of flagstones

Measure and mark out with fish line and pegs.

80 to 100mm space is recommended between flagstones.

Place a spade of mortar next to fish line and spread lightly with trowel.

Wet flagstone and place on to mortar mixture to line up with fish line.

Tap flagstone down to desired level with white rubber mallet, to avoid marking the flagstones.

Remove excess mortar from between flagstones.

Where gravel or pebbles are placed between the spaced flagstones, a plantex membrane can be laid on compacted soil to avoid weeds growth.

\* Avoid walking on flagstone paver for next 12 hours.
